Essays of up to 3,000 words (excluding references, but including text within figures, tables and legends) are invited to be submitted by any undergraduate medical, dental, veterinary or biomedical student

Format: Double line spacing

1. **One copy** of your essay as a word document - please include the name of your current Institution on your essay

2. **One signed copy** of the **certificate of originality**

Please note – your essay will not be entered into the competition without this certificate.

Closing date: **31st August 2024**

The undergraduate essay prize of £500.00 will be presented to the winner at the 2025 Summer meeting. Travel expenses to attend the Society meeting presentation are also awarded to UK undergraduates; overseas undergraduates are eligible for prize money only, but not travel expenses. Details of the 2025 meeting dates and venue will be given nearer the time of the meeting.
