

## TRAVEL AND CONFERENCE BURSARY

The Travel Awards Scheme was introduced in 2004 to promote scientific communications at major international meetings. Applicants whose work is/has been selected for presentation will be favoured. Please note the Society meetings are **excluded** from these awards.

The terms and conditions of the Travel and Conference Bursary are as follows:

- 1. Concessionary members of the Society in good standing for at least 12 months and Undergraduate Members. Members who are in substantive NHS consultant, academic or similar permanent positions are ineligible for this scheme.
- 2. A sum of up to £500 will be available to cover the costs of travel and/or registration fees and must **supplement** monies from other sources. Evidence of monies from other sources must be provided with the application.
- 3. The Society logo must be used on all presentations.
- 4. A one-page report of the value of the meeting must be sent to the Society office within three months of attending the meeting. Failure to provide a report will preclude future support in this and other schemes run by the Society.
- 5. The Society will normally withdraw funding if the grant is not acknowledged and accepted within 6 months of the offer

Applications are reviewed upon receipt by a sub-committee chaired by the Meetings Secretary.
